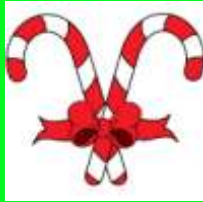

2016 Concours d'Elegance Opportunity

We have been asked to provide a "Circle of Volkswagens" at the next Concours d'Elegance at St. John's in Plymouth, MI (for 2016). There will be only ten VW vehicles allowed for this very special event. The organizers are looking for early unmodified VW models with special interest status. These could include military or special bodied cars (not "Kit Cars"), early Beetle or Karmann Ghia cabriolets, Type 3 or 4 models, a 1973 notifying: a Sports Bug", a type 34 Karmann Ghia, a "Thing", and an early 23 window van for example.

The selection will be made by a committee from within the Concours organization. This is a great opportunity to show your special VW at this prestigious car event. More information about this event can be found at www.concours.usa.net.

For consideration, please forward one or two photographs of your vehicle with a short explanation of its special nature. For example, my 1990 VW Fox could be included as the VW Fox was only produced between 1987 and 1993, and exclusively manufactured in Brazil by VW for worldwide sales.

WHAT'S NEW FOR 2016!

As we boldly go into the year 2016 the board has been trying to innovate better ways to finance the club. We wanted to maximize new membership while minimizing profit taken in from the car show. The reasoning behind this is, as a non profit organization we are only supposed to take in a certain amount of profit that is a percentage of actual membership dues. So... going forward the car show will have free entry to all paid members (we will have a list of paid members at the entrance to the show) dues must be paid by February. **If you are not a paid member you may become one at the entrance to the show for \$15.00 and then you may enter the show.** If you are not a member and do not wish to pay the \$15.00 to become a member then you may NOT pay an entrance fee to enter the show. So in essence all people at the show are now members. All fees paid to enter

a car into the show are now membership fees. This will both grow the club and minimize the expense of going to the show to our membership. As part of signing up as a new member you will receive a name tag in the mail at no cost.

The Saturday Event will consist of a cone race, and a very high end rock and roll



concert put on by the Magic Bus Band. Keeping in mind our expenses for the Saturday event is in excess of \$3500.00 we will be charging all entrants to the concert \$10.00, this includes members and non members alike.

There will be no charge for the cone race this year.

We hope that in the future all of our events grow in fun and scale alike. We want to keep our club solvent as well as within the law and be fiscally responsible. We want to promote growth and fellowship in all that we do.

Though we are putting our cars to sleep for the winter, we can dream ahead to the events of 2016!

We try to do an event as a club each month (though we often see each other at many more events than that!)...But we have room for events that you want to see!
